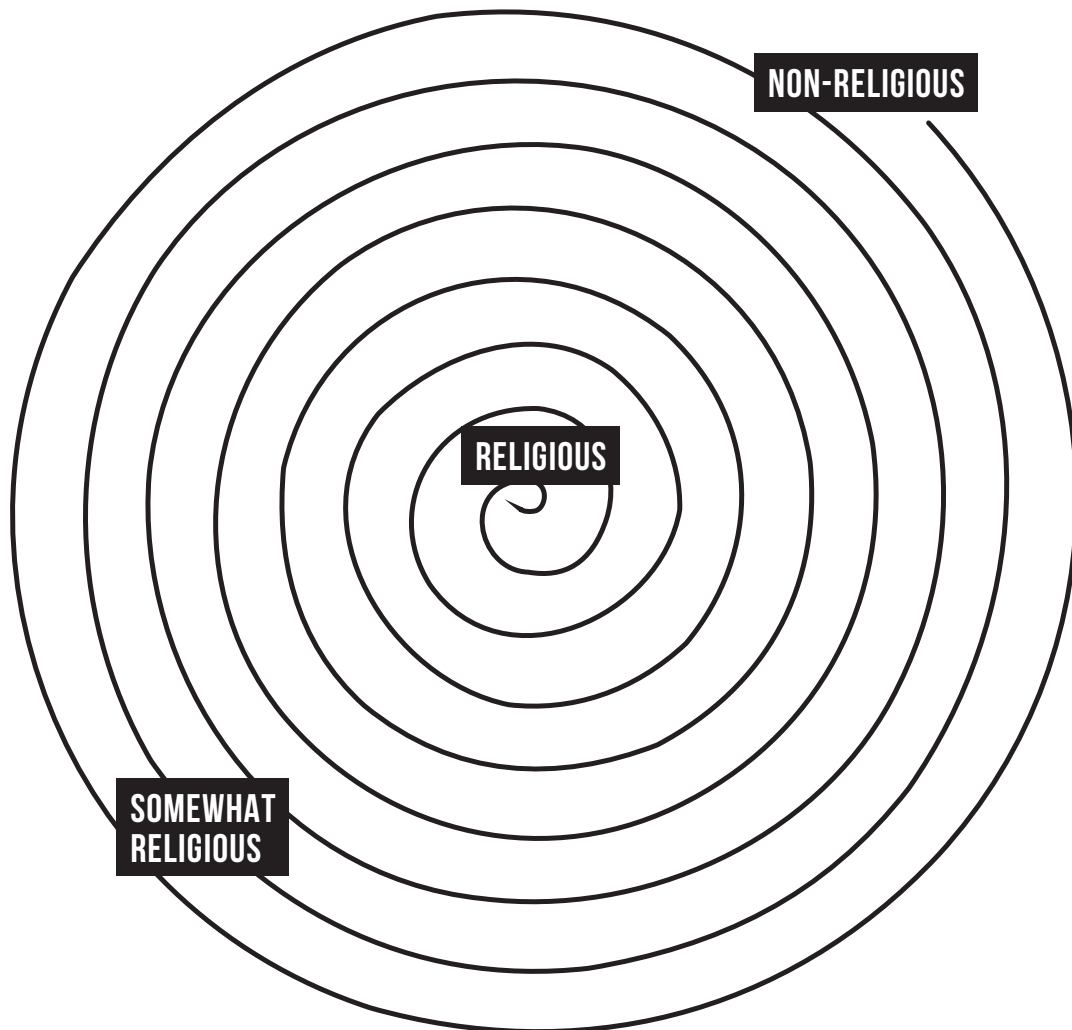


WORKSHEET: SPIRALS

Jesus tells the disciples to take the gospel from Jerusalem (religious headquarters) to Judea (kind of religious), to Samaria (other religions), to the ends of the earth (non-religious).

This spiral out is the call of all disciples to go from the religious to the wider world. On the spiral track your weekly influence. Name people and places you interact with that, as a disciple, are part of your mission.



Starting with the centre of the spiral, write the name of the Christian community you live in, or the group of Christian friends you would call your church. As you journey out from the centre mark the growing non-religious places in which you travel. On the last third of the spiral think about the places you would fear going – places where you would struggle to travel because it would take you out of your comfort zone.
